

Minutes from the Palm Coast Traveling Sams January 2019 Meeting

The meeting was held at Flagler County Firehouse #6. There were 9 Chapter families represented.

President S. Jackson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Guests – There were no guests in attendance.

Membership Report – R. Jacobs suggested that, in an effort to grow the membership, signs could be placed in the windows of rigs stored in public spaces with contact information regarding our Chapter. He made some of the signs and handed them out.

New Business:

The Chapter voted to camp bi-monthly and to camp in the odd months starting in March. The first outing will be held at the Georgia State Rally in Perry, GA. Since this is a State Rally there will not be a host for the outing.

The FL State Rally at Okeechobee KOA will be the 2nd Chapter outing. The dates are April 30 – May 5. The Rally will be followed by a "Post Rally" outing which will run from May 5 – May 10.

There will be no official Chapter outings in June, July or August but if a member has a notion to go camping, they are encouraged to notify other members to see if they might be interested. That holds true not only for the summer months but any time that the Chapter does not have an outing scheduled.

The September outing will be the 18th – 22nd.

The November outing will be the 15th -19 followed by the FL State Rally in Eustis which is the 19th - 24th.

The Chapter Christmas outing will be the 4th – 8th of December.

The locations for the Okeechobee “Post Rally” outing and the September, November and Christmas outings are yet to be determined. Wagon Master L. Trotter will contact campgrounds, make the preliminary reservations and pass the location information to the membership.
