A discussion followed concerning expenses at Christmas outings – R. Jacobs stated that the SOP spells out that the Chapter contribute \$300 and the balance of the costs be divided by the number of rigs present, not to exceed \$20 ( \$10 for single). Regular outings – expenses divided by number of rigs, not to exceed \$20 per rig ( \$10 per single).
